

GOVERNMENT FUNDED HOURS SCHEMES

Wandsworth Council, on behalf of the government, administers a scheme which allows eligible children to access early education and childcare without charge. We receive funds from the council on an hourly rate basis for each eligible child.

AGE 2 FUNDED HOURS

We do not participate in this scheme.

AGE 3&4 UNIVERSAL FUNDED HOURS (15 HOURS), AVAILABLE TO ALL PARENTS

We offer a maximum of 12 hours per week

Each child is allowed a total of 570 hours per year over 38 weeks i.e. 15 hours per week. However, as we open for more than 38 weeks, we stretch these hours, so each child will receive a maximum of 12 hours per week, over the approximately 48 weeks that we are open each year.

AGE 3&4 ADDITIONAL FUNDED HOURS (30 HOURS), AVAILABLE TO ELIGIBLE PARENTS ONLY

We offer a maximum of 12 additional funded hours per week

In addition to the universal funded hours, some parents are eligible for an additional 570 funded hours. Due to our stretched weeks, we can offer up to 12 hours of additional funded hours each week.

Funded hours can be accessed anywhere during afternoon or mornings placements. However, **in order to access the funding at the nursery, parents must agree to an Additional Services Package Charge.**

The total paid will not be any more than our advertised rates for three and four year old children. This charge covers any additional hours attended over the funded hours and everything that is over and above the standard EYFS requirements, such as consumables, meals and snacks (if applicable to the attendance pattern), an all fully qualified staff team, specialist tutors, premium facilities and location.
